## Congratulations to our 2025 Duces!

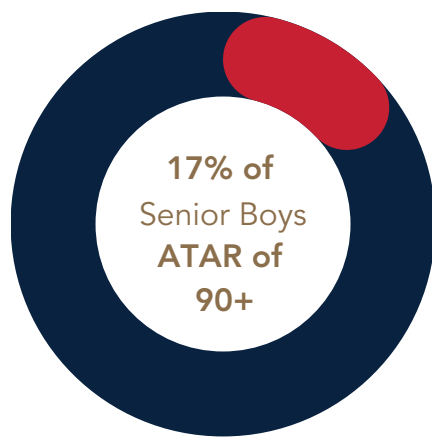
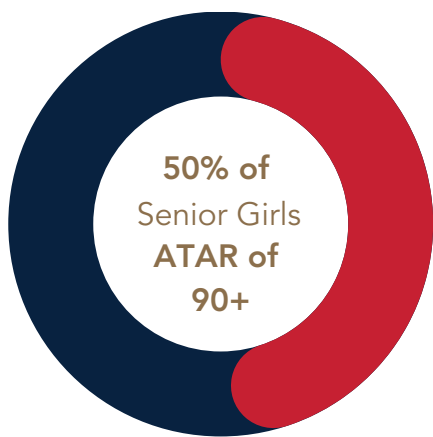
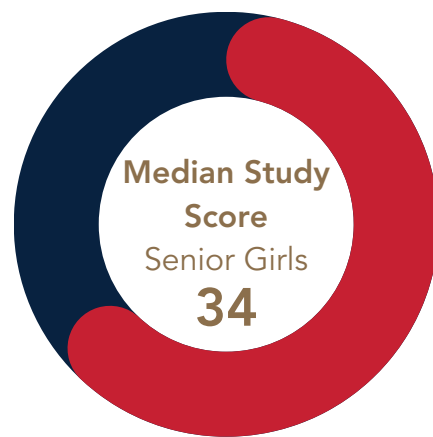
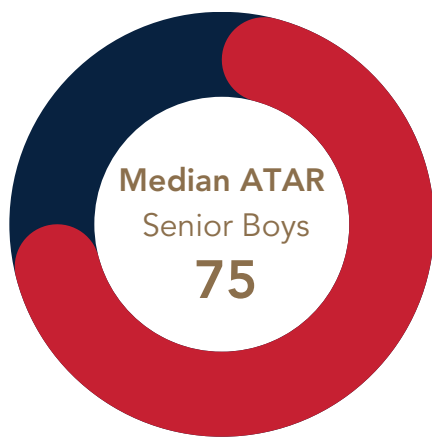
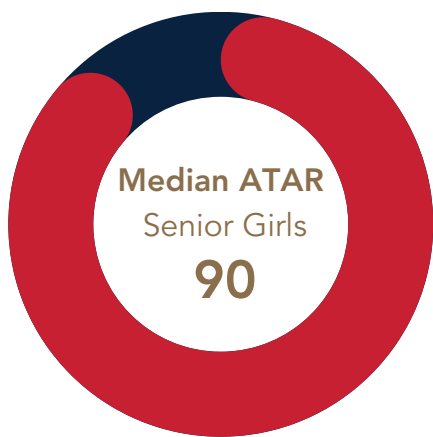
