# Conditions of participation

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Welcome to Academic Assessment Services (AAS) online testing. We're committed to ensuring a secure and fair testing environment for your child. To participate, we ask that you read and agree to the following terms and conditions.

## **Test integrity and confidentiality**

As a parent or guardian, you play a crucial role in upholding the integrity and confidentiality of the online testing process. By agreeing to these terms, you confirm that:

- You understand the importance of valid test data and keeping test materials and processes confidential.
- You consent to the collection of personal information on behalf of your child.

## **Identity verification**

We take identity verification seriously to ensure a fair testing environment. Here's how we do it:

- Your child's identity will be confirmed.
- No assistance is allowed during the examination.
- No copies of test questions in any form will be made, stored, or shared with others.

## **Secure testing environment**

To maintain a secure testing environment:

- Your child will use a locked-down browser that restricts access to other websites and applications.
- A computer with a camera is required to transmit their photograph and record the testing session.

By agreeing to these terms, you acknowledge and consent to the recording of the testing session, which is essential for identity verification. Without this agreement, your child cannot proceed with the test.

## **Data protection**

Rest assured that any recordings taken during the testing will be deleted as soon as they are used to verify your child's identity. Images of your child will not be used for any other purpose.

## **Identity verification documents**

Your child will need to upload ONE photographic proof of their identity during the log-in process. Acceptable documents include:

- Passport (including a recently expired passport)
- Student/library card with a photo
- Front page of the school report with your child's photo
- Snapshot of the student's account from the 'Compass' portal
- Most recent school photo of your child.

## **Parent/guardian responsibilities on examination day**

On the day of the exam, you have important responsibilities:

- Assist your child in logging on to the online testing platform 15 minutes before the exam starts.
- Ensure that your contact information is correct for communication.
- Leave the test room once your child has successfully logged in.
- Supervise the scheduled break and ensure your child re-engages with the test promptly.

## **Examination day**

On the day of the exam:

- Students will complete two sessions.
  - Session One includes General Ability, Reading Comprehension, and Spelling (Spelling is not tested for Scholarship examinations), followed by a recess break (20 minutes).
  - Session Two includes Mathematics and Written Expression.
- All assessments are multiple-choice, except Written Expression which must be typed.
- Students must take the tests at the scheduled time, and additional time will not be permitted.
- Once testing begins, students should follow the prompts to complete each section.

## **Testing environment**

Your child must have a quiet and private space for the duration of the test. They should not have access to web-enabled devices, including smartwatches or phones, or any additional resources like calculators, dictionaries or books.

## **Materials required**

Ensure your child has two sheets of blank paper and a pencil. These may be used for rough work or planning responses during the examination and must be destroyed on camera at the end of the session.

## **Collection of personal information**

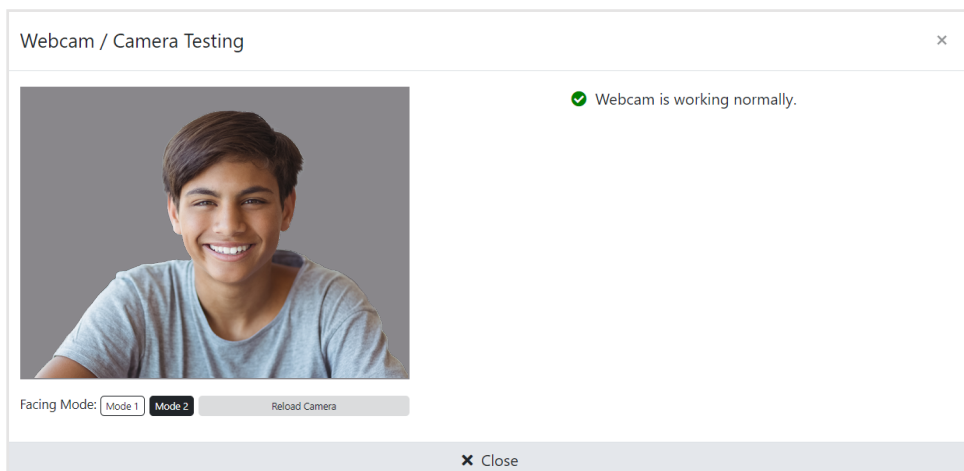

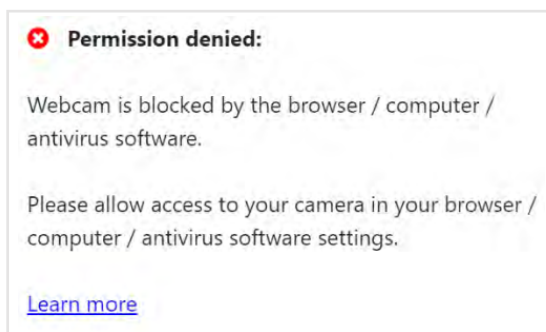

# Examination day

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## Important Reminders:

We strongly advise logging in and setting up at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time. This ensures that students are fully prepared for the commencement of the online testing. Punctuality is key to a smooth testing experience.

At the conclusion of the exam, please ensure that your child destroys any rough working out paper on camera. This step is crucial to maintaining the integrity of the testing process.



### Can someone be present during the test taking?

- Students are allowed assistance to help set up the online testing, but under no circumstances can someone assist or be in the same room as the student once the test commences. Students will also be monitored throughout the exam, just like in-person exam conditions.

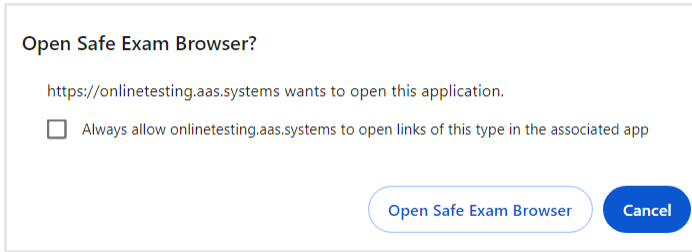

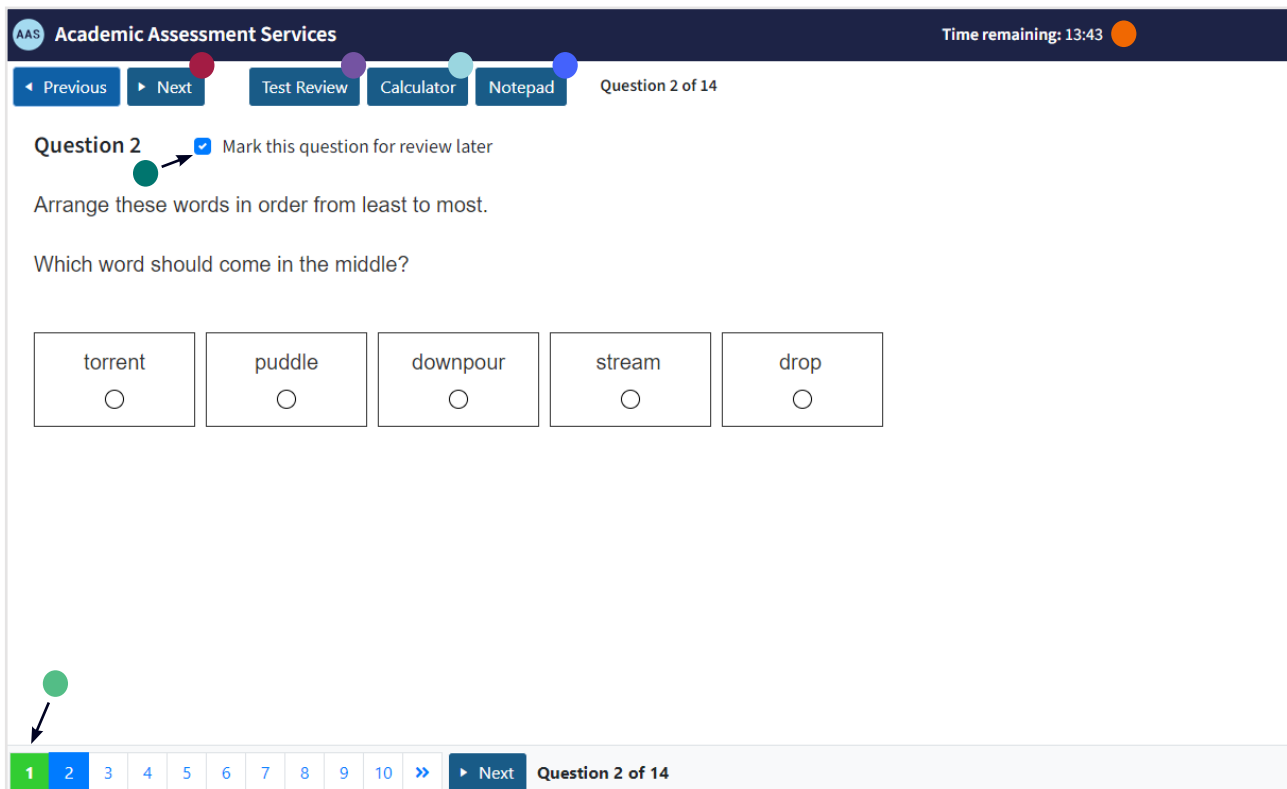
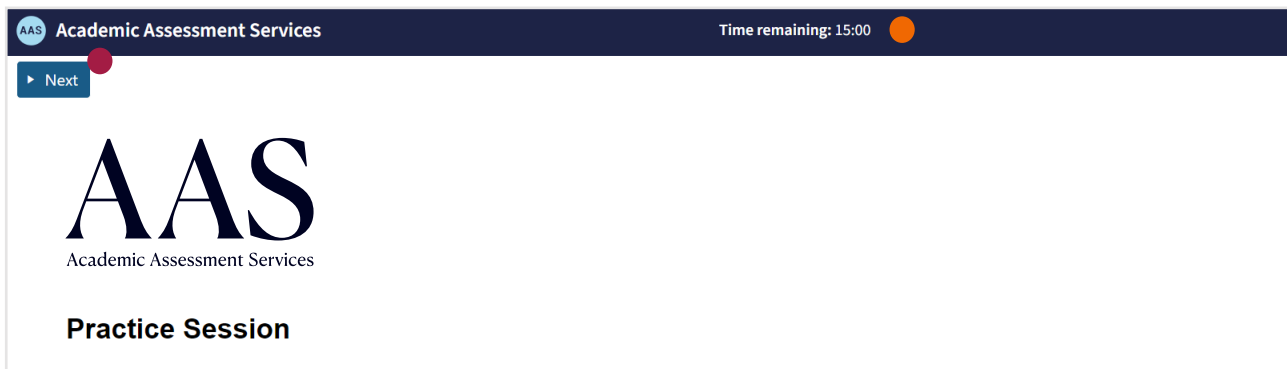

# Frequently asked questions

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## **If my child is sitting an AAS online exam for more than one school, can their results be shared?**

- Results are not shared between schools, students must sit each individual exam.

## **Can my child test without a webcam?**

- To maintain transparency, under no circumstances can students test at home without their webcam on.

## **What can I do if my webcam isn't working?**

- If the camera isn't showing on your screen, you may have it opened on another browser. Close all browsers, or you may have to restart your computer.
- Ensure that you click Allow when prompted to grant camera permission in the pop-up.
- Certain computer models, like Lenovo, the webcam may have an on/off switch; please ensure it is set to the 'on' position.
- Check the facing mode: Mode 1 / Mode 2.

## **What if there are technical difficulties on the exam day?**

- Please create an IT Support ticket in the system for assistance.

## **Can someone be present during the test taking?**

- Students are allowed assistance to help set up the online testing, but under no circumstances can someone assist or be in the same room as the student once the test commences. Students will also be monitored throughout the exam, just like in-person exam conditions.
- Parents are only permitted in the room if there are technical issues and to send a ticket to IT Support.
