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ROLLCALL

Alston Coaches uses RollCall, a school bus transport management system, which uses the latest software technologies to allow the school to track the buses and the students who are onboard. The system also allows us to give parents visibility of bus location, student status and transactions as applicable through a Parent App. It is important that students comply with the RollCall system as it may be used to assist in the event of an emergency.

Please note the following:

- Students are to use their SMBG Student ID Card to 'tap on' to the RollCall device at the bus entry when boarding and to 'tap off' the RollCall device upon departure.
- RollCall does not apply at this stage to buses for excursions.
- Alston have requested that students have their card ready prior to boarding to avoid any delays to the service operations.
- At the commencement of the school year, parents and guardians will receive a welcome email from RollCall with instructions on how to register, and links to further informational videos. Further information can be found on the company website at www.rollcall.com.au.
- Only parents who are signed up to use the bus service will have access to the specific route's location and student status through the Parent App.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Travel on these services is offered both AM and PM, return, one way or on a casual basis.
- Please note all times are estimates only and are traffic-dependent on the day.
- All registered passengers are required to use their SMBG Student ID card to tap on and off the Roll Call system each time they use an SMBG chartered bus service. It is important that students comply with the RollCall system as it may be used to assist in the event of an emergency.
- Casual travel passes can be obtained from student services at the Berwick Campus and from reception at the Officer Campus.
- Replacement Student ID cards can be ordered from student services at the Berwick Campus and from reception at the Officer Campus. A replacement Student ID Card will cost \$10.00. Your child will still be able to use the bus services while they wait for their SMBG Student ID card to arrive.
- For the school to offer the SMBG1 Transfer service free of charge, all families who apply to use this service **must submit** a Private Bus Conveyance Allowance application. The funds received from the Department of Education will be retained by the school.
- All fares for SMBG2, SMBG3, SMBG4 and SMBG5 will be charged to your child/children's school fee account at the commencement of the 2025 School Fee billing period, or upon commencement of travel notification. The prices quoted in this document are GST free. The Charter Bus Application Form 2025 will become a valid Tax Invoice upon payment.
- If I no longer require my child/children to use the service, I understand that I will be charged bus fares until I give written notification.

STUDENT GUIDELINES FOR SAFE TRAVEL

Students are reminded that they must comply with all school policies when using SMBG bus services for reasons of safety of all passengers and the driver.

This includes:

- Students must be at the bus stop at least 5 minutes before scheduled arrival and departure time.
Please note the bus cannot wait at a stop as it delays the times of subsequent stops.
- Buses are only permitted to stop at designated stops; students may not board or disembark at other points.
- Students may only disembark at their designated stops.
- At all times, students must remain seated while the bus is in transit.
- Students must always use seat belts.
- Noise levels from students are always at a safe and acceptable level.
- Students must follow directions from the bus driver for their safety.
- Students must respect the bus property. A student who willfully causes damage will be responsible for the cost of the repair for the damage caused.
- A student that fails to comply with the school's policies and behaviours will forfeit the use of the services.

JUNIOR SCHOOL STUDENTS

- Year 5 and 6 students may use the bus service upon confirmation from the Head of Junior School.
- Year 3 and 4 students may use the bus service as long as they are travelling with a sibling in Year 5 or above and have written confirmation from the Head of Junior School.
- Junior school parent/guardian must be present with their child at AM and PM stops.
- The bus driver will not allow a junior school student to disembark the PM stop unless a parent is present at the stop or the junior school student is accompanied by a senior school student.
- In the event a parent/guardian is running late for the scheduled time PM stop, the student is to be picked up from another stop further along the route. Please note the bus cannot wait at a stop as it delays the times of subsequent stops. Buses are only permitted to stop at designated stops.

'BE AWARE' BUS SAFETY

A reminder to parents of students who travel on buses to or from school. Records show that most accidents and injuries do not happen while on the bus, they happen at bus stops before the bus arrives or after the bus has pulled away. Please remind your child/children that they must wait until the bus has driven away before attempting to cross the road. If possible, parents are advised to wait on the same side of the road or walk across to meet students at the bus stop.



HIGH FIRE DANGER DAYS OR EXTREME EXTERNAL EMERGENCY

If a fire occurs during school time in a zone serviced by the school, ALL students on possible affected bus routes will be held at that school until the all-clear is given. [On Code Red days, school buses would most likely not be operating.](#) Bus drivers must make themselves aware of possible hazards on their routes and determine areas of temporary refuge (this information must also be held by the Principal coordinating bus arrangements). Buses with students on board must not leave the school without the approval of the Principal. Bus drivers must carry some form of a communication device to contact Emergency Services or the school. Bus drivers must notify Emergency Services (typically the Police) and the school immediately via two-way radios or mobile phone if a bus is delayed enroute.

Bus drivers must not allow students to alight from buses if fires are burning in the area unless parents and guardians are waiting for them. If no-one is waiting, buses will take students to the nearest safe area. (Safe areas to be agreed to by Police and Principal coordinating bus arrangements). Bus drivers must have a card showing telephone numbers of the school, Police and local Fire Service. If the road is blocked, the bus should return to the school, unless otherwise directed by the Emergency Services personnel.

CONVEYANCE ALLOWANCE PROGRAM

Conveyance Allowance may be [available to students attending SMBG Officer Campus Only](#) travelling by public transport, private bus or car and whose nearest school is not serviced by a free school bus provided under the School Bus Program. The Conveyance Allowance Program is a contribution towards transport costs and is not intended to cover the full cost of transporting children to and from school. Parents may be able to claim an allowance if the student lives further than 4.8 km from the school, and if SMBG Officer Campus is their nearest non-denominational single-gender school. **SMBG Officer Campus students who meet the applicable criteria are eligible to claim. Students at SMBG Berwick Campus are not eligible to claim as the campus is not zoned for this allowance.**
